Annual Meeting Summary - Sat., Nov 5, 2016, Bob Evans, Fairmont, WV

The annual meeting was held on Saturday, November 5, 2016, at the Bob Evans restaurant in Fairmont, WV.

Attending were Bill, Kelly, Gerry, Steve, Amanda, Mary, Laurel, Kelvin, Bruce, and Jennifer.

At the meeting, we covered the finances of the club, the year-end membership, the total number of rides in 2016, and a brief summary of the year's activities. Also, the annual election of officers was held. Next, on the agenda was a slide presentation on the club's C&O bike tour this spring, and finally Bill entertained us with some cycling related cartoons.

Annual Meeting 2016 Officer's election:

President - Kelly Williams. Ride Captain - Amanda Bise. Secretary/Treasurer - Open Position

Membership for 2016: 92 members total Finances: as of November 1, 2016 - We have \$2592.88 in our club account.

Spring Spectacular 2016: We had 47 cyclists attending this year's Spring Spectacular, which was held starting from Mount Morris, PA, on Saturday, April 30. Also, we held the Bonus Ride on Sunday, May 1. And, even though it was raining Sunday, we had 17 riders turn out for either the trail ride or the road ride.

2017 CRC Officer's meeting - March 11

The officers of the CRC, along with Bill Foster meet in February. We discussed many items of business, including scheduling our annual pizza party at Colasessano's on

Saturday, March 10th, at 6:00 PM; club membership as of 2/10/2017 we had 43 members; also the balance of the CRC bank account was \$2238.16, (also as of 2/10/2017). Other items included renewing the domain name of CRCyclists.org and renewing club insurance through American Specialty for 2017, a total of \$417.72 for 92 insured members (2016 membership count). We also have LAB (League of American Bicyclists) membership through 12/1/2017. We approved our sponsoring of the Spring Spectacular Weekend, to be held on May 6 and May 7. Also, two of our rides (April 23 and April 29) will be part of the WV Physical Activity Network. Last item, Amanda will take over the administration of the Facebook page, and she will send out the weekly reminders on both the Facebook page and on the website. (All members are welcomed to attend the officer's meetings.)

2016 The cycling year in review (Notes from Kelly Williams at the annual meeting):

As usual, we started the year planning for the Spring Spectacular, beginning in the middle of winter. However, this year, we made some big changes, planning to start from Mount Morris, with a new route and holding the ride on a Saturday, April 30. There was a good turnout on Saturday, of 47 cyclists, for this great new route. Plus we held two bonus rides (both a trail ride and a road ride) on Sunday, May 1. (And, as always, thanks to all of those on the committee who gave their time and energy to help with this ride: Mary, Bill, Lisa, Jennifer, Jack, Don, Chuck, and Frank.)

We did start the cycling year, in March and April, with some warm up rides, such as Shannon Run, Mount Morris out and back, Prickett's Fort out and back, Mon River trail, and the ever popular Snake Hill. Also, Joe Leroy led some road rides in Harrison County, where he was joined by Jennifer, Lisa, and others.

We were able to ride the entire C&O Canal towpath in April (4/17 thru 4/21): Phil, Jennifer, Bruce, Buddy, and myself. It was very pretty riding the towpath in early spring. Thanks to Phil Slate for leading and planning it. And, I am grateful that we had no rain. As we go into May and June, the weather warms up, and we have Joe Leroy and Bill Foster, leading rides in Harrison county, while in Mon county, we have both trail rides and road rides. Plus, on the schedule, we had a couple of Bike and Kayak rides organized by Jennifer, biking on the trail and then stopping at the Twin Spruce marina, for a kayak ride.

A large group (both CRC and MBC members) rode the annual Marietta ride on June 3 and 4. Weather was perfect on Saturday, but on the return trip on Sunday we had to cycle for over twenty miles through pouring rain.

The annual picnic at Prickett's Fort state park was held on Sunday, June 12, Thanks to Bill Foster, as grill master and to all who rode to the picnic, and, a big thanks to all who brought food. Positive Spin sponsored several rides and picnics this summer, there is always a good turnout of cyclists when food is offered. And, it is always fun to do a group ride with another cycling group. Fourteen cyclists who rode the Rowlesburg ride on Saturday, Sept. 3. Thanks again to Bill Foster for being the ride leader, the sag driver, and operating the snack stop.

The annual metric century was held on Sept. 11. Five cyclists completed it: Lisa, Larry, Jennifer, Amanda, and myself. We rode the entire Mon river trail, from the state line to Prickett's Fort and back. Plus, of course, after this ride, we had the mandatory after-ride

gathering at the Mountain State Brew Pub. However, on the other hand, the Prosperity Century on Sept 18 was a bust. Only Jack and I showed, and first one of us had a flat and then it started raining hard. So we decided to cancel the ride.

On September 24 and 25, a group went from Connellsville to Rockwood and back, staying overnight in Rockwood. The riders were Dana, Jennifer, Amanda, and Phil. The Over Mount Davis was held on October 15 with Larry, Tim, Chris, and Dana; up and over Mount Davis, then return via the GAP trail.

Also, in September and October, Bill lead 6 rides around Harrison County, on the rail trails that are being developed in Harrison County.

All around, a good year, with a lot of good rides. I am looking forward to 2017 and another year of cycling.
